This **Memorandum of Understanding** is intended to provide clinical, medical and counselling services to the UG / PG students of the Peoples Education Society's P.E.S. College of Physical Education which is a Higher Education Institute (HEI) covers teachers education institute (TEI) through Parvati Pratisthans Para Medical Institute's runs the Parvati Hospital is intended to provide cooperation between the doctors to provide medical/clinical cooperation to the students by recognizing the benefits to their respective students from the establishment of medical links, hereby agree to enter into this agreement for the following purpose.

### **1. PURPOSE OF AGREEMENT**

The purpose of this agreement is to develop physical fitness, mental health, medical remedies to the sports person, athlete of P.E.S. College of Physical Education and to develop academic and educational cooperation, establish a collaborative program in Health issues to the athlete, sportsman and sportswoman and the students of UG/PG degree of Physical Education between the two institute and to cooperate in their mutual interest for a range of higher educational activities.

### **2. AREAS OF COOPERATION**

Subject to the availability of funds, resources and approval of the authorized representatives or Heads of the Institute of the Parvati Hospital and the Head of the institute of P.E.S. College of Physical Education, both institutions agree to develop the following collaborative activities:

- a. Cooperating to conducting the health camp, fitness guidance program, time to time health checkup, psychological counselling, blood donation camp and awareness program.
- b. Conducting joint research and development project for college students.
- c. Cooperation in individual research projects of students.
- d. Organization of lectures, symposia, international meetings, conferences and workshops related to health, fitness and disease
- d. Exchange of researchers and students
- e. Exchange of information, teaching materials, technological and scientific publications
- f. Providing opportunities for professors and researchers to give lectures for UG/PG students.
- g. Search for opportunities to collaborate in the future
- h. To share Laboratory facilities

3. **IMPLEMENTATION**

- 3.1 All programs or activities implemented under the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be mutually agreed upon in writing, including the necessary budget for the program of activity as the need may arise.
- 3.2 Each of the participating institutions shall be fully responsible financially for the activities carried out under its direction or by its staff, except as otherwise agreed by the parties.
- 3.3 The parties will designate one officer each who will develop and coordinate specific programs or activities between them.

4. **INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY**

Intellectual property rights of work carried out at each partner institution shall normally vest with respective institution.

5. **DURATION AND RENEWAL OF AGREEMENT**

This Memorandum of Understanding will become effective immediately after signature by the representatives of both institute for a period of **02 years** and is subject to revision or modification by mutual agreement.

6. **AMENDMENTS**

- 6.1 This Memorandum of Understanding may be amended by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both institutes.
- 6.2 In the event of any unforeseen incident during collaborative activities in either campus agree to negotiate a mutually acceptable solution.
- 6.3 Should any disagreement arise out of the application, interpretation or implementation of this Agreement, the institutes shall endeavor to exercise best efforts to negotiate their differences.


7. **TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT**


